TAX PENALTY

A proposed 16% tax penalty will be levied on all outstanding properties after January 15, 2023. This includes utility transfers, current and arrear taxes and any other balance on the tax roll.

If you were on the pre-authorized tax payment plan last year there is no need to re-apply. If you would like to apply this year, and your tax account is paid in full, please ensure that your application is returned prior to December 10, 2022.

PROPOSED CHANGES TO TAX BYLAW

Council approved 1st reading of the new tax bylaw on October 26th. The new tax bylaw will move the December 31^{st} penalty to January 15^{th} , and reduce it by 2% to a 16% penalty. The July 15^{th} penalty has been split into 2 separate dates and reduced. The new proposed penalties will be July 15th at 8% and October 15th at 6%. This proposed tax bylaw will result in a net decrease of 6% in penalties over the year.


MESSAGE FROM ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

Winter is coming! And with that we would like to remind everyone in the event your car breaks down or stalls in the winter to remember the following:

- * Stay with your vehicle
- * Do not overexert yourself
- * Place bright markers on the antenna or windows
- * Keep the interior dome light turned on
- * Do not run your car for long periods of time while the windows are rolled up or in an enclosed space this is a carbon monoxide hazard. If you have to keep your vehicle running to stay warm, be sure to clear snow away from the exhaust pipe and run the vehicle only as long as needed to stay warm.
