ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE INTEREST PENALTY

Interest Penalty On Unpaid Accounts Receivable Bylaw 2022-13. Please be advised that effective May 31, 2023, the Town of Millet will implement an interest penalty of two percent (2.0%) per month on all general accounts owing to the Town of Millet that remain unpaid in excess of thirty (30) days.

LAGOON SITE



The lagoon site will be open every second Saturday from 8:00am - 12:00pm starting May 13, 2023. The only items that will be accepted are trees and branches.

WATER RATIONING

From May to September of each year, all residents are required to practice water conservation for outdoor watering. Properties ending with an odd number may water on odd numbered days only and properties ending with an even number may water on even numbered days only.

COUNCIL MEETINGS

Council Agendas are prepared one week prior to a Council Meeting. Those wishing to place items on the agenda must have the information in to the Administration Office PRIOR to 10:00am on the Thursday before the scheduled meeting. Requests can be submitted to admin@millet.ca.

TAX DEADLINE

The 2023 Tax and Assessment notices are scheduled to go out at the end of May/beginning of June. Remember that the deadline for tax payment, without penalty, is July 15, 2023. Unpaid tax penalty dates and amounts are as follows: January 16, 2023 (16%), July 16, 2023 (8%), and October 16, 2023 (6%). Anyone that was on the pre-authorized payment plan last year does not need to reapply. If you would like to sign up for the 2024 plan, you must do so prior to April 15, 2024.

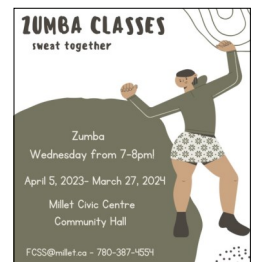
MESSAGE FROM ENFORCEMENT SERVICES
