2023 taxes are due July 15, 2023. Please contact our office immediately if you did not receive your 2023 tax notice and to update your information.

Penalties are as follows:

8% July 15, 2023

6% October 15, 2023

16% January 15, 2024

KICK IT TO THE CURB



Residents of Millet - Don't put your useful or unwanted items in the garbage - Give them away for FREE. Leave items at the curb or end of your driveway with a 'FREE' sign on August 27, 2023. Please remember to respect other properties - Do not walk or drive on lawns & do not discard items on another lawn. All items not taken must be removed from the curb or driveway by 10pm the same day (Bylaw Enforcement will issue fines for items not removed).

WATER RATIONING

From May to September of each year, all residents are required to practice water conservation for outdoor watering. Properties ending with an odd number may water on odd numbered days only and properties ending with an even number may water on even numbered days only.

ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

When should you call Bylaw Services?

1. Construction noise
2. Parking complaints
3. Snow removal
4. Animal complaints
5. Noise complaints

Please ensure you are maintaining your property. This includes cutting your grass in the front, back, boulevards and back alleys if your property is joined to one.

Abide by the local speed limits. The playground zone is in effect all year round not just when school is in session. The speed limit is 30 km/hr from 8:30am to one hour past sunset.
