DOG BAG DISPENSER



Dog bag dispensers are now installed around town. Please use them for your pets. They are checked weekly for refilling. Please call the Town Office if you find these empty. REMINDER FROM ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

A friendly reminder from your Community Bylaw Officer. As a resident of the Town of Millet, all persons within the Town of Millet owning, controlling, or occupying property that adjoins any sidewalk shall remove or cause to be removed and cleared away all snow, ice, dirt, debris or other material from any sidewalk adapted to the use of pedestrians. Such removal shall be completed within 48 hours from the time that the snow, ice, dirt, debris, or other material was formed or deposited there. Any person who fails to comply with this section is guilty of an offence and may be issued a violation ticket in an amount specified in Schedule A of the Bylaw. In default of any person complying with subsection above, and in addition to any other remedy available to the Town of Millet for noncompliance with the bylaw, the Town may arrange to have the sidewalk cleared and any cost thereof shall be paid to the Town upon demand and failing payment, such cost shall be charged against the property as a special assessment.
