NO plastic film (bags, etc) or containers that held dangerous chemicals or hydrocarbons (oil, etc.)



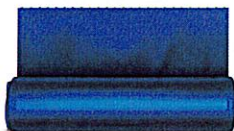
NO glass, batteries, styrofoam, machine parts, mixed materials (toys, etc.), plastic-coated paper items, or construction debris (siding, etc.)



Rinsed plastics marked



Lids of all kinds must be disposed of with waste.



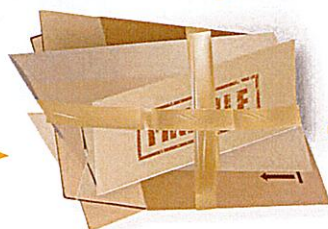
Use blue bags ONLY. Recyclables in black or clear bags or other receptacles will not be collected.



Flatten boxboard and place inside blue bags.



Flatten all cardboard and bundle together with tape.



Place bundled cardboard under your blue bag.



Flattened cardboard placed in another box no larger than 24" X 24" is also acceptable.

Boxboard & Cardboard

Boxboard - cereal, tea, pasta, cracker and other food packaging boxes (plastic or foil pouches removed), personal care & other boxboard packaging

Cardboard - flattened and bundled/contained as illustrated on reverse

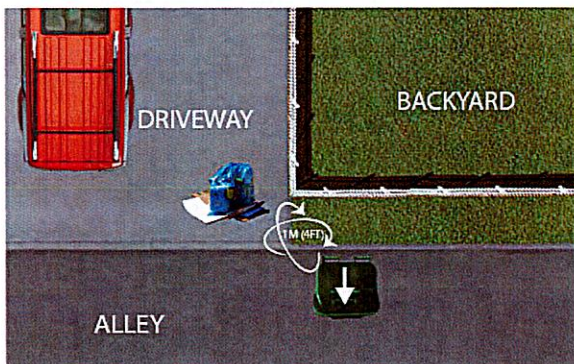
Food cans (no lids)
Milk jugs
Refundable beverage containers
Non-refundable beverage containers
Heavy plastic packaging marked recyclable (rinsed)

PLACING YOUR BLUE BAG



Blue bags must be clearly visible from the roadway with cardboard flattened inside, bundled beneath or contained within another box. Keep blue bags clear of cart(s).
